



The Leadership Scholarship Program (LSP) recognizes outstanding high school graduating seniors who have achieved excellence in leadership. Up to 25 students will be selected for the scholarship. Established in 1977 to develop exceptional leadership skills among promising scholars, this program has a long-standing history at Arizona State University. More than a scholarship program, students become integral members of the university community.

Students in the program will participate in the following:

- CED 194, a leadership development course designed specifically for this program.
- Mentoring by an ASU staff member.
- Monthly meetings with all current ASU LSP students.
- Social activities, such as a leadership retreat and holiday events.
- Community service.
- Networking with LSP alumni.
- Living on the campus of their major (required for first-year recipients).

Financial Award

The LSP award is one of ASU's institutional scholarships. ASU does not combine institutional scholarship awards. In the event you become qualified for a New American University Scholarship award (i.e., President's, Provost, Dean's, Regents High Honors Endorsement) and are selected for the Leadership Scholarship Program, you will only receive the scholarship with the highest value. If accepted into the Leadership Scholarship Program, participation is mandatory. The LSP award is a \$13,000 annual scholarship for non-resident students, renewable for three additional years (for a total of eight consecutive semesters). Note: The award does not fully cover the current cost of non-resident tuition. Recipients may use the scholarship for tuition and fees, housing and other educational expenses.

Eligibility Requirements

- Must be actively involved in Key Club or a nationally recognized leadership organization.
- 3.25 un-weighted GPA.
- Must be able to provide verification of citizenship, permanent residency, or other lawful immigration status.
- Must have a completed ASU application for undergraduate admission on file by December 3, 2012.

Application Instructions

Please complete the application and submit it with the following items by December 7, 2012:

- A copy of your official high school transcript(s).
- A list of high school activities (include brief description of organization, dates of participation and leadership positions held).
- A list of community service and volunteer projects (include total hours and dates of participation).
- A list of honors, awards and special leadership programs attended (i.e., classes, workshops, conferences).
- Answer two of the following three questions in essay format (a maximum of two pages per answer):
 - 1) How do you intend to make an impact at ASU?
 - 2) Describe a challenging experience you faced during high school, and explain what you learned from this experience and how this experience made you a stronger leader.
 - 3) If you were asked to provide a speech concerning your passion in life, what would you write?
